The Braemar Competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the [current rulebook](#), as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating [website](#).

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and who are currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. Please refer to the current rulebook for non-U.S. citizens.

ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:

Test Level: Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline in the discipline the skater is entering. Note, “skating up” is at the discretion of LOC and athletes may not skate down in any event.

Age restrictions/requirements: Singles free skate events (well-balanced program) have the following requirements:

- Juvenile: Girls – 12 years or younger; Boys – 13 years or younger
- Open Juvenile: Girls – 13 years or older; Boys – 14 years or older
- Intermediate must be under the age of 18
- Adults must be 21 years or older

Skaters entering pre-juvenile and lower events will be divided as closely as possible by age should the number of entries warrant more than one group.

COMPETITION REGISTRATION:

Online entry only with secure credit card payment is available at <https://braemarfsc.org/braemar-competition/>, services supplied by the EntryEeze system. Upon receiving your application online and email will be sent to the skater’s coach to review the entry(ies) for accuracy, correct level and desired events. Additionally, an e-mail will be sent to the skater’s home club official to certify the skater’s standing within the club.

Deadline for Entries: on-line entries must be received by Midnight on Friday, May 20, 2022. The entry fee is \$150.00 for all IJS and 6.0 events, and \$25.00 for each additional single event. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the Competition Chief Referee, and must be accompanied by a \$25.00 late fee.

NOTE: A fee of \$25.00 will also be charged for any changes to entries, competition level, age, events

entered, etc. made after May 20, 2022.

TEST CREDIT: Skaters may purchase a test credit at the time of registration via EntryEeze and merchandise section. Fee is \$25. Test credit may be purchased in advance until May 16th, 2022. After that test credits may be purchased at registration desk for \$25 payable by check made out to BCLFSC.

REFUND POLICY: Entry fees will not be refunded after entry deadline unless no competition exists or the event is canceled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals.

SCHEDULE: Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time during the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available.

CANCELLATIONS: Any scheduled event may be canceled or combined if there are fewer than three (3) entrants or if the Referee determines that insufficient ice time is available to complete all events in an orderly manner. Skaters will be notified regarding cancellations and event combinations.

PRACTICE ICE: Official practice ice is not being offered, but practice ice will be available for pre-purchase on-line with registration as well as after the schedule has been posted and will be sold on a first-come basis. Skater's music will not be played during practice sessions. A maximum of 20 skaters will be scheduled on practice ice. Unsold practice ice may be purchased at the Registration Desk on a first-come basis. Practice ice is \$20 per 20min session.

FACILITIES: The competition will be held at Braemar Arena, 7501 Ikola Way, Edina, MN 55439, 952-833-9500, <https://braemarfsc.org/>. There will be a concession stand available.

SCHEDULE: Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time during the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available.

MUSIC SUBMISSION:

ALL SKATERS MUST SUBMIT MUSIC ELECTRONICALLY VIA ENTRYEEZE. Competition music for all events that require music must be submitted electronically via EntryEeze by the music deadline of June 1, 2022 11:59 pm. Any music file submitted through EntryEeze after the deadline will incur a \$25 fee. After you have paid for your events, the system will prompt you to upload your music for each event that requires music. If your music is not available at that time, you can logout of your account and return later to upload your music by going to the "competition" tab and then selecting "my music". All music uploads must be in .MP3 format. CDs will only be used as BACKUP for technical difficulty. A duplicate CD should be readily available in case of any problems with upload. Music downloaded for the competition will be deleted after the event is complete

JUDGING SYSTEM:

- The International Judging System (IJS) will be used for the following events:
 - *Well Balanced Free Skate Program Events: Pre-Preliminary – Senior (Planned program content sheet IS required.)
 - *Short Program Events, Juvenile – Senior (Planned program content sheet IS required.)
 - *Excel Free Skate Program Events – All Excel Plus Pre-Preliminary, Excel Plus Preliminary, Excel Plus Pre-Juv, Excel Plus Juv, Excel Plus Intermediate & Juvenile – Senior Excel.

All competitors skating in these events need to submit the planned program content form online, using our online registration system (EntryEeze). Paper submissions will NOT be accepted. If your coach has a multi-competition account with EntryEeze, he/she will also be able to see your PPC information and update it, prior to the deadline, if something changes or is incorrect in your information. The deadline to submit the

form is June 1, 2022. A \$25 fee will be assessed for not submitting a PPCS.

> The 6.0 Majority Judging System will be used for:

*Well Balanced Program Free Skate Events: No Test - Excel Beginner, Excel High Beginner, Excel Pre-Preliminary, Excel Preliminary, Excel Pre-Juvenile & High Beginner Freeskate

*All compulsory events, spins & jumps events.

LIABILITY: U.S. Figure Skating, Braemar City of Lakes Figure Skating Club and Braemar Arena accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in this competition. This is in accordance with Rule 1600 of the official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

ONSITE CHECK-IN: Check-in will open on Friday, June 24 at 7:00am and will be located inside the main entrance of Braemar Arena.

LOCKER ROOMS:

Locker rooms and changing areas will not be available at this competition. All athletes are expected to arrive to the arena ready (costumes, hair, make-up etc.). Athletes will be provided with an area to put skaters on, but will not be permitted to change in public restrooms.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented to all skaters placing 1st through 4th in all Braemar Competition events. The awards will be presented to competitors (in the West Arena) immediately following the result posting. Results will be posted online via EntryEeze and the Braemar City of Lakes Figure Skating Club website.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY: Each competitor will receive 1 free video download and competition photos as their competition gift. Additional videos and photos will be available for purchase. Perkins Media will be the official photographer/videographer for Braemar Competition.

Note, per U.S. Figure Skating policy, photographing and/or recording of any one other than your own skater is strictly prohibited.

OFFICIAL NOTICES: An official bulletin board will be maintained at event registration desk. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the bulletin board frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are requested to arrive 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule of events will be posted prior to the competition.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:

To be a credentialed coach at a sanctioned non-qualifying competition, coaches must meet the compliance requirements listed below and verified by the U.S. Figure Skating.

Coach/Choreographer (domestic/non-foreign):


- ✓ Must be a current full member of U.S. Figure Skating either through a member club or as an individual member.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must submit information for, proper payment of \$30 and successfully pass a background check. *
 - The background check will be valid for two seasons, the one in which it was completed plus one additional.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must complete annual SafeSport Training. *
 - The training will be valid for 365 days from date of completion and there is no cost for the training/certification.
- ✓ Must complete the Professional Coach/Choreographer Coaching Education Requirement (CER) through the [Professional Skaters Association \(PSA\)](#).

- ✓ Must submit proof of general liability insurance with limits of \$1 million per occurrence/ \$5 million aggregate.
- ✓ Must agree to the U.S. Figure Skating Code of Ethics. *
- ✓ Must complete three waivers: 1) Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release and Indemnification Agreement, 2) Medical Consent and 3) Name and Likeness Release and Consent Agreement. *
- ✓ If attending a qualifying competition or traveling as a part of Team USA and/or International Selection Pool (ISP), must be a full member of the [Professional Skaters Association \(PSA\)](#).

Learn to Skate USA Coach:

- ✓ Must be a current full member of U.S. Figure Skating either through a member club or as an individual member OR Learn to Skate USA instructor membership
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must submit information for, proper payment of \$30 and successfully pass a background check. *
 - The background check will be valid for two seasons, the one in which it was completed plus one additional.
- ✓ If 18 years or older, must complete annual SafeSport Training. *
 - The training will be valid for 365 days from date of completion and there is no cost for the training/certification.
- ✓ Learn to Skate USA Instructor Certification completed OR U.S. Figure Skating compliance coach (details above)
